The Council of Ministers commissioned consultant Sir John Elvidge to [report](#) on creating the Isle of Man Government as a Single Legal Entity. It will be come before *November Tynwald for endorsement.

On the face of it the proposal seems sensible, but digging deeper some commentators see unintended consequences, believing it to fundamentally alter the relationship that the IOM citizen has with the State.
